Summary for Special Events Permit (Public Hearing):

The Vail Valley Chamber & Tourism Bureau has submitted the appropriate materials for application of a special events permit. This special event permit is for the VVCTB Chamber Mixer to be held on Wednesday, March 15, 2006 at Community Banks, 70 Benchmark Rd., Avon. Representatives, Robin Litt & Jamie Healey from VVCTB will be present at the meeting to answer any questions about the event. The premise has been posted with notice of the public hearing.

Background & Discussion:

Special Event Permits

The Liquor Authority will consider one special events permit as listed above. Special Events permits are issued by the Liquor Enforcement Division and a Local Authority to allow qualified non-profit entities to sell, serve or distribute alcohol beverages in connection with fund raising events. Because of their temporary nature, needs and desires (reasonable requirements of the neighborhood) are not considered by the licensing authorities as a condition of issuance. Applications are made directly with the local licensing authority having jurisdictions over the place of the event. Article 48 of Title 12 regulates the issuance of special events permits and is attached for your review.

The applicant for the special events permit have submitted the following materials:

- ✓ Applications for a Special Events Permits (State form DR 8439)
- ✓ Map of Premises & Diagrams where liquor will be served.
- ✓ Certificate of Good Standing
- ✓ Related state & local Fees
