Background & Discussion:

There is a new manager at Sheraton Mountain Vista and C.R.S. 12-47-301(8) states that the licensee shall report any change in managers to the state and local licensing authorities within thirty days after the change. The Permit Application and Report of Changes form is used to report such changes. Liquor licensed establishments renew the liquor licenses on an annual basis, submitting application materials first to the Local Licensing Authority. Once approved at this level, both renewal applications and change in manager are forwarded to the State of Colorado for review and issuance of the state license as well.

Discussion:

The Town Clerk, Town Attorney, and Avon Police Department have reviewed the applications submitted; all application materials are in order. A report from the Police Department is attached for each license; this report addresses a background investigation on the applicant, an update on whether or not there have been any incidents reported at this location and any smoking related violations. Since Sheriff Masry is a new manager with Sheraton Mountain Vista, he has been invited to attend the meeting. As well, Carlos Diaz from Fiesta Jalisco will be at the meeting to answer any questions related to the calls for service as noted on the police report.

Financial Implications: There are local and state liquor licensing fees associated with renewal applications that have been submitted to the Town.
