

1. ROLL CALL

She explained the video was of a young boy telling a story about catching a fish that was caught in a glow bracelet. This story prompted her to want to discuss and deal with lake pollution. The Committee was unsure if that would be within the scope of the Committee's purpose. Town Councilor Jake Wolf suggested that this issue be brought to Public Works Director Gary Padilla but he expressed he may be wrong and will discuss it with Town Manager Eric Heil to gather his thoughts.
