



Question 11: What type of retail business would you like to see in Avon?

Summary:

The Town of Avon received 728 responses to Question 11. The responses represent some tensions in selecting businesses for Avon. Many respondents said they would like to see national retailers come to Avon such as Trader Joe’s, Target and Marshall’s, but others expressed that Avon should prioritize small locally-owned businesses. There were also responses that requested no more businesses come to Avon to preserve the small-town feel, while others called for more of everything, especially diversity in food and shopping options that cater to the middle market like Target, or that offer diversity like ethic and health-food and more casual/fast dining options. There is a desire to build a mall-type shopping experience, and to offer more family-centric, activity-base businesses like bowling, dancing or an arcade. Specific requests included: home goods, sporting goods, bars/breweries, coffee shops, electronics and party supplies stores. A small handful of respondents requested allowing marijuana industries in town, while nearly the same number expressed that this would be undesirable.
