



## Town of Avon Community Energy Efficiency Program

### Home Energy Assessments

- **\$50 up front cost**; any sized home
- \$50 given back in a rebate when homeowner completes a weatherization, energy efficiency, renewable energy, or building electrification project recommended on the assessment report, within 6 months
- \$100 value in Quick Fixes for FREE at the time of assessment

### Weatherization, Energy Efficiency, and Safety Rebates (doubled)

- **Max \$1,000/year for homes** (not to exceed 60% of any project cost with all rebates, including utility)
- **Max \$2,000/year for businesses & multifamily buildings** (not to exceed 60% of any project cost with all rebates, including utility)
- Projects may include: Ventilation, Heat Pump, Duct Sealing, Heat Pump Water Heater, Heat Tape Timers, Air Sealing, Insulation, Home Radon Mitigation, HVAC Tune-Up, Induction Cooking, LEDs, Lighting Controls, Chillers, EC Motors, Smart Controls, Pool Pumps, Programmable Thermostats, Cellular Shades, Storm Windows, and more

### Solar PV Rebates

- **Max \$1,000/year for homes**
- **Max \$2,000/year for businesses & multifamily buildings**

### Building Electrification Rebates (additional \$500)

- **Max \$3,500/year for homes** (not to exceed 60% of any project cost with all rebates, including utility)
- **Max \$6,500/year for businesses & multifamily** (not to exceed 60% of any project cost with all rebates, including utility)
- Projects (must) switch from natural gas or propane to electric, and may include: Cold Climate Heat Pump, Heat Pump Water Heater, Induction Cooking, Heat Pump Clothes Dryer, Electric Fireplace, Energy Storage (Batteries), EV Charging in Multifamily Building lots

#### **REBATE CHECKLIST**

- HOME ENERGY ASSESSMENT / BUSINESS ENERGY WALK-THROUGH** – enroll online
- ENERGY COACH** – talk with us at Walking Mountains (before starting your project)
- REBATE REQUIREMENTS** – verify your project meets minimum specifications/requirements
- REBATE APPLICATION** – complete online (after your project is completed/paid)
- PHOTOS / DOCUMENTATION** – gather and provide to your Energy Coach
- UTILITY REBATES** – ask your Walking Mountains Energy Coach to guide you

The following chart shows income level limits for households to participate in three (3) different programs available locally, which can help with energy improvements in homes. Energy Coaches at Walking Mountains can help people apply for and go through any of these low-moderate income programs. Free upgrades may be available with WAP and CARE.

### Walking Mountains LMI (WM-LMI above) Incentives for 2022:

- **FREE Home Energy Assessments**
- **\$2,000 for Weatherization, Energy Efficiency, and Safety Rebates**
- **\$2,000 for Solar PV Rebates**
- **\$4,000 for Electrification Rebates**

*Specific rebate details shown above are **annual max amounts per household** (which may go towards one or more projects until max is reached). All rebate rules at the beginning of this document apply. There is an **80% of project cost max allowed back in rebate(s)** when also considering all utility rebates. Each measure has specific requirements to qualify, please talk with an Energy Coach at Walking Mountains before starting your project.*
